# Health tips for summer

#### (American heart Association)

\* Hydrate! Drink plenty of water before, during and after physical activity to avoid dehydration. For lowcalorie flavor, add slices of your favorite fruits such as melon, oranges, or mint to a pitcher of water and refrigerate for two hour

\* Protect your family from the sun: wear wide brimmed hats, always apply water-resistant sunscreen with at least SPF 15 and reapply sunscreen every 2 hours
